*In addition, DA, HRA, CCA, Medical Aid, Hospitalization expenses, conveyance expenses LFC and retirement benefits are admissible as per the rules of the Bank. Perquisites like Quarter, Furniture etc shall be provided as per rules.

It is clarified that Persons with Disabilities will have to work in Branches/ Offices which have posts identified by the Bank as suitable for them.

Candidates belonging to Reserved Category, including Persons with Disabilities, for which no reservation has been announced, are free to apply for vacancies announced for General category. The number of vacancies and also the number of reserved vacancies is provisional and may vary according to actual requirements of the Bank.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: NATIONALITY/ CITIZENSHIP:

A candidate must be either i) a Citizen of India or ii) a subject of Nepal or iii) subject of Bhutan or iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) & (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the interview conducted by the Bank but on final selection the offer of appointment may be given only after the Government of India has issued the necessary eligibility certificate to him/her.

2. RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT: (In case of candidates belonging to the following categories)

- The relaxation in upper age limit is cumulative as per Govt. of India guidelines.
- An ex-serviceman who has once joined a Government job on civil side after availing of the benefits given to him as an Ex-Serviceman for his re-employment, including a job in the Public Sector Undertaking ceases to enjoy ex-serviceman status for further employment.
- All persons eligible for age relaxation under 5 above must produce the domicile certificate at the time of interview, from the District Magistrate in the Kashmir Division within whose jurisdiction he/ she had ordinarily resided or any other authority designated in this regard by the Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir, to the effect that the candidate had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir Division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during 1st January 1980 to 31st December 1989.
- Above relaxations are available only if the candidates fulfill the various conditions prescribed in the Govt. of India orders and instructions in this regard. To claim age relaxation, reserved category candidates should submit a copy of the Community Certificate.

3. Definition of Categories of Disabilities: Definition: Physically Challenged Persons (PC)

(a) An Orthopaedically Challenged (OC) person is one suffering from Locomotor Disability or Cerebral Palsy. Persons who suffer from not less than 40% of relevant disability (as certified by a Medical Board appointed by the Center/ State Govt) would be eligible for reservation in services/ posts.

Locomotor Disability means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limb or any form of cerebral palsy.

Cerebral Palsy means a group of non progressive conditions of a person characterized by abnormal motor control posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the pre-natal, peri-natal, or infant period of development.

(b) **Deaf & Hearing Impaired (HI)** : the deaf are those persons in whom the sense of hearing is non-functional for ordinary purposes of life i.e. total loss of hearing in both ears. They do not hear, understand sounds at all even with

amplified speech. Hearing impairment means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.

- (c) **Visually Impaired (VI)**: The visually impaired persons are those suffering from blindness or low vision. Blindness - refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions
(i) total absence of sight, (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses, (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse.

Person with low vision means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction, but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

The visually impaired candidates and candidates whose writing speed is affected by cerebral palsy can use their own scribe at their cost during the written examination. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply: The candidate will have to arrange his/ her own scribe at -

- His/ her own cost.
- The academic qualification of the scribe should be one grade lower than the stipulated eligibility criteria.
- The scribe should be from a discipline different from that of the candidate for the posts of Specialist Officers. For the post of Probationary Officers, the scribe can be from any academic discipline. The scribe should possess 60% or lesser marks.
- Both the candidate as well as the scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking, confirming that the scribe fulfills all the stipulated eligibility criteria for a scribe as mentioned above. Further, in case, it later transpires that he/ she did not fulfill any of the laid down eligibility criteria or suppresses material facts, the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the written examination.
- Such candidates who use a scribe shall be eligible for extra time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination.

All Educational Qualifications should be from a recognized Board/ University/ Institute. The Educational Qualifications prescribed for the post are the minimum. Candidates must possess these qualifications and must attach proof thereof along with the Printout. **The work experience, wherever required, should be relevant to the post applied for and should be post qualification i.e. it will be counted from the date of acquiring the prescribed qualification. Experience should be as a full time permanent employee.**

5. Selection Procedure

Merely satisfying the eligibility norms does not entitle a candidate to be called for written test & / or interview. All the eligible candidates who apply and whose applications are received in time will be considered for selection process, which is as under:

6. Written Test:

- (i) The Written test will comprise of Objective tests consisting of Reasoning Ability, Quantitative Aptitude, General Awareness and English Language and also a Descriptive Paper on Professional Knowledge/Subject for Specialist Officers and General Topics for Probationary Officers.

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- (ii) The question papers except the Objective test of English Language will be in bilingual i.e. Hindi & English version.
- (iii) Depending upon number of vacancies, only a certain number of candidates from the candidates merit listed in the Written Test will be called for Interview / Group Discussion. Final selection will be made on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in the written test & Interview/Group Discussion and will be strictly on merit basis.
- (iv) The written test will be held on **14.6.2009 (Sunday) for Specialist officers and on 21.6.2009 (Sunday) for Probationary Officers.**
- (v) Dates of examination are tentative. The exact dates will be communicated to the candidates through call letter for each examination. The Bank, however, reserves the right to cancel or make any change in the date of examination, if need arises.
- (vi) **For appointment of Specialist Officers & Probationary Officers, the written test will be held at the following Centers. The address of the Venue will be advised in the Call Letter.**

9. How to Apply :

Candidates are required to apply On-Line through website www.unitedbankofindia.com.

No other means/ mode of application will be accepted.

Candidates applying for more than one post are required to take demand drafts for each post separately and are required to apply on-line for each post separately

10. General Instruction

- 1) The Bank takes no responsibility for any delay in receipt or loss in postal transit of any application or communication.
- 2) Only candidates willing to serve anywhere in India should apply.
- 3) Any resulting dispute arising out of this advertisement shall be subject to the sole jurisdiction of the Courts situated at Kolkata.
- 4) Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
- 5) The Bank would be free to reject any application, at any stage of the recruitment process, if the candidate is found ineligible for the post for which he/ she has applied. Decision of the Bank in all matters regarding eligibility of the candidate, the stages at which such scrutiny of eligibility is to be undertaken, the documents to be produced for the purpose of the conduct of examination, interview, selection and any other matter relating to recruitment will be final and binding on the candidate. No correspondence or personal enquiries shall be entertained by the bank in this behalf.
- 6) An application printout not accompanied by requisite application fee and/ or postage, relevant certificate(s) where necessary, or not signed by the candidate or incomplete in any respect will not be entertained. - (b) For Physically Challenged the Competent Authority to issue Disability Certificate shall be a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or State Govt. The Central/ State Govt. may constitute Medical Boards consisting of at least 3 members out of which one shall be a specialist in the particular field for assessing locomotor/ cerebral/ visual/ hearing disability as the case may be.

Action Against Candidates Found Guilty of Misconduct : Candidates are advised in their own interest that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated and should not surpass any material information while filling up the application form. At the time of written examination/ interview, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of (i) using unfair means during the examination or (ii) impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or (iii) misbehaving in the examination hall or taking away the question booklet (or any part thereof) / answer sheet from the examination hall or (iv) resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/ her candidature for selection or (v) obtaining support for his / her candidature by unfair means, such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself / herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable :

- (a) To be disqualified from the examination for which he/ she is a candidate.
- (b) To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period from any examination or recruitment conducted by United Bank Of India
- (c) For termination of service, if he/ she has already joined the Bank.

The Bank would be analyzing the responses of a candidate with other candidates to detect patterns of similarity, if any as per the laid down procedure.
